

## **SAFETY**

### **SAFETY RULES & TIPS**

- No running in or around the dining room
- Smoking is not permitted in any building or designated work area
- Shoes & shirts are to be worn in the dining room
- Zip Hydro Boil is not to be used by children
- No sitting or standing on tables
- Keep body parts away from the underside of windows
- Keep away from metal poles and structures during electrical storms
- Native animals (possums, goannas, foxes, dingoes) are sometimes around. Don't feed them or annoy them. Report any dingo sightings to Camp Elim's manager
- Falling palm fronds hurt. Be aware when near the lakeshore during strong winds
- Speed limit on the main road (The Lakes Way) is 100 kph. Take extreme care when crossing to the beach
- Don't go to the beach on your own. Make sure you mark your exit point as it is sometimes hard to find your way back, especially at night
- The Adventure Tower is out of bounds
- Buoyancy vests must be worn when using Camp Elim's canoes & rafts
- Be aware offshore winds can blow you a LONG way quickly
- The EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY AREA is between the basketball court and the Adventure Tower
- For everyone's health, please take all used cups and glasses to the dishwashing area in the dining room immediately after use
- In an emergency, please consult the "ACTION IN THE EVENT OF" flip chart in your room, unit or cabin. Familiarise yourself with the "SITE EMERGENCY LOCATIONS" in the flip chart

## **EMERGENCIES**

In the event of an emergency please assist our emergency personnel. Incidents may include :

- Violent Weather Conditions
- Building Fire
- Bush Fire
- Personal or Bomb Threat
- Internal Emergency
- Evacuation
- Medical Emergency
- Missing Persons

### **YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Please read the "ACTION IN THE EVENT OF ..." Flip chart found in all accommodation and buildings
- Please make sure you are aware of the EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY AREA and move your guests to that point if required (i.e. near the Adventure Tower)
- Have a list of your guest's names (in English)/numbers so that all guests can be accounted for
- Assist emergency personnel to ensure the safety of you and your guests
- Report all emergencies to Camp Elim's Manager immediately
